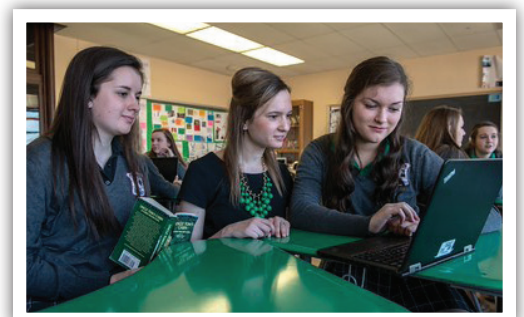
## ADMISSION INTO THE PROGRAM IS COMPETITIVE AND SELECTION CRITERIA INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:

- Score a minimum of 85% or above on the HSPT
- Recognized academic achievement, Christian leadership and service to others through scholarship essay response
- Received no grade below a 78% on report cards and attains a cumulative average of 85% or above
- Completed the Seton Application/Admissions process
- Consistent school attendance



## STUDENTS ACCEPTED INTO THE PROGRAM HAVE THE OPPORTUNITY TO:

- Attend various leadership workshops
- Enroll in a rigorous course load
- Take part in leadership training
- Be awarded a renewable academic scholarship
- Be enrolled in a test-prep class for PSAT and ACT
- Take part in unique service opportunities
- Attend and engage in enrichment activities through partnerships with local universities
